

Core Transfer Map

About the Program

RCC students without a declared a major who plan to transfer may take classes fitting into these categories, at RCC or any community college in Oregon. All classes listed below will transfer to meet at least 30 credits of general education requirements toward a bachelor’s degree at any of Oregon’s seven public universities. Students interested in a specific major should consult with an Advisor in that area when picking their specific Core Transfer Map classes.

| Arts & Letters (6-8 credits) | 2 courses required. See Humanities courses listed in the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree * See an advisor for recommended courses |
| Social Sciences (6-8 credits) | 2 courses required. See Social Science courses listed in the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree * See an advisor for recommended courses |
| Natural Sciences (8-10 credits) | 2 courses with labs required. See Science courses listed in the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree * See an advisor for recommended courses |
| Math (4-5 credits) | One 4 or 5 credit course at 100 or 200 level required. See Mathematics courses listed in the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree. * See an advisor for recommended courses |
| | Additional Requirements |
| Cultural Literacy | At least 1 required course must also meet the Cultural Literacy outcomes. See courses with footnote ¹ in the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree. |
| At least 30 credits | A total of 30 credits must be in the total. To apply additional credits, after meeting with an advisor, select course(s) from the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree. |
| Completion Standards | All courses must be passed with a grade of “C-“ or better and students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the time of the award. |
